

Guidelines for submission of Abstracts and Articles

FOR ABSTRACTS

Please consider the following:

- Include a short bio of the author(s) in the beginning of the abstract in a box – Name, address, educational qualification, relevant experience in the field in 200 words.
- Suggest a title of the article.
- Summarize main views, ideas or facts to be covered in the article in 1000 words.
- Include a bibliography.
- Please remember, abstracts once submitted may not be modified unless the review panel is convinced that the modification is essential.

Technical details:

- **Font type and size:** Use 'Times New Roman' in 12 point font size for English and use 'Preeti' in 16 point font size for Nepali.
- **Margins:** Leave 1 inch on all sides (top, down, right and left).
- **Spacing:** Use double spacing.
- **Deadline:** The last date for submission of abstracts is 15 January 2015, 17:00 hours Nepali time.
- **Methods of submission:** You can use either of the following methods:

FOR ARTICLES

Please consider the following:

- Title
- Elaborate article in 3,000 words

Technical details:

- **Font type and size:** Use 'Times New Roman' in 12-point font size for English and use in 16-point font size for Nepali.
- **Margins:** Leave 1 inch on all sides (top, down, right and left).
- **Spacing:** Use double spacing.
- **Deadline:** The last date for submission of articles is 31 March 2016, 17:00 hours Nepali time.
- **Referencing:** Use adequate referencing APA format for citation.
- **Originality and scope:** No plagiarism is acceptable and case studies are not considered.
- **Substantiation and coherence:** Arguments should be based on reliable facts, sound judgment and the thoughts should be coherently presented.

GENERAL POINTS:

- The review panel or the editor will make the final decision as to which abstract or article will be selected for the publication.
- Due to space constraints in the publication, there is no guarantee that all good abstracts will be selected. And, there is no guarantee to get all articles published either.
- A modest honorarium will be provided to the published articles but no costs will be reimbursed incurred during the preparation and submission of abstracts or full articles.

TENTATIVE TOPICS TO BE COVERED:

1. Accomplishments
2. Outstanding Issues
3. Mechanisms/Institutions
4. Prospects for future

The authors are independent to present their ideas on the aspects of CPA which have been realized through multiple institutions working in the past decade and prospects for the future of Nepali society with some key issues which remain debated or unresolved. We encourage to focus on one of the aforementioned four themes on their abstracts and then the articles, considering different aspects of the Comprehensive Peace Accord including some generic aspects like political transformation, state restructuring, inclusiveness, social transformation, economic prospects, public infrastructures, land reform, security sector reform, transitional justice, human rights, peacebuilding, etc. We expect the abstracts and the articles to be of high quality measured by depth of the research and basis of evidence.
